SERIALIZATION OF LESLIE PRODUCTS

Leslie products manufactured prior to December 31, 1962 are assigned serial numbers in a numerical sequence by product category. (for complete listing by product and year, see list on page 2)

Leslie products manufactured between Jan. 1, 1963 through Feb. 1974 are identifiable by serial numbers consisting of the year of order, order number and item number.

The following products manufactured between January 1963 and February 1974 were not assigned serial numbers:

PRESSURE REDUCING VALVES

A, K, and M Classes, Airmate Classes and P-Type Panels.

BACK PRESSURE REGULATORS

CUC Classes

TEMPERATURE REGULATORS

Direct-Operated M Classes

WHISTLES

All small Leslie-Supertyphon Air Whistles up to and including A-425 manually operated and AE-200 electrically operated, Automatic Whistle Controls, Whistle Operating Valves and Solenoids sold separately.

Leslie products manufactured after March 1974 are identified in the following manner:

STANDARD PRODUCTS and cataloged items whose class, together with size, are totally descriptive for normal replacement part purposes (item is made to standardized bills and test procedures) will not be individually serialized, but instead will have their nameplates permanently marked with a date code, which signified the Production (assembly) Batch of the particular item and permits relating to our formal Drawing Control System.

This serial number will be on the nameplate only, and the sales order number will not appear on the product.

Example: A product assembled in the 2nd quarter of 1974 will bear a nameplate stamped with the letters BA. "B" signifies the 2nd quarter, "A" denotes 1974 as the year of manufacture. A product assembled in the 1st quarter of 1975 will be stamped "AB", "A" indicating the 1st quarter and "B" indicating 1975 as the year of manufacture.

The codes for the quarter and year are:

The following products manufactured after March 1974 bear a unique individualized serial number:

- All Steam Whistles
- Large Air Chime Whistles
- Automatic Whistle Control Timers
- All Control Valves and products manufactured for nuclear, high specification, Navy and special products identified with an "X" in the class designation.

The serial number for the products listed above consists of the following:

- One letter identifying the year of the order.
- A five digit number which signifies the order number.
- A two digit number which signifies item number.
- Three letters which signify the test sequence code.
